Tytuł pracy doktorskiej: Cultivating the traditions and values of Poznań (written in the Greater Poland dialect) by teaching primary school children and teenagers

The dissertation includes, among others: discussion of the situation related to endangered languages, as well as an analysis of the most important documents containing legal regulations related to the protection of endangered languages and their teaching. The paper also presents the basic linguistic and dialectological terminology necessary to write about issues at the intersection of education and linguistics and dialectology. The issue of the development of Poznań's linguistic identity from the beginning of settlement to the interwar period was also extensively discussed, as well as selected examples of activities aimed at protecting regional languages undertaken by the Swedes, Kashubians and Silesians. The work also includes an extensive research section in which qualitative research is described and documented. Posts posted by fans of the Poznań dialect on selected dialect fanpages were examined. In addition, the work includes a review of the sociolinguistic and didactic concepts needed to formulate the theoretical assumptions and the pedagogical concept of the curricula to be created. The dissertation also includes a brief description of the types of curricula, their composition and the content that should be included in them. The most important part of the work is a discussion of the process of creating programs and a description of problems occurring during the work and justification of solutions.
