Faculty of Educational Studies of Adam Mickiewicz University hosts the international meeting of COST Action (CA17114) "Transdisciplinary solutions to cross-sectoral disadvantage in youth" (Poznań, 27-28.06.2022). Action website: https://young-in.eu/

The meeting covers the International Conference on YOUNG-IN findings "(Dis)advantaged youth -studies, contexts, solutions" (Poznań, 28.06.2022, 11.00-19.00). The conference is going to be held in <u>stationary</u> form with presentations of empirical and theoretical findings on the action topic, covering: youth (dis)advantages inemployment, starting a family, becoming active citizens; knowledge-based social investment policy for youth and comparative youth studies.

We invite young researchers (PhD students, post-docs, PhDs) from AMU who share an interest in the conference topic to send their contributions for the **Flash Talk Session** (5-minutes presentations with discussion). The flash talks aim to present current research findings, receive feedback and develop potential international cooperation.

We will accept presentations with empirical contributions on the youth topic. Demands toward proposal: title and abstract of 100-200 words. The abstract should mention 1) the main research question/review goal, 2) the used methodology/analytic approach, and 3) main research findings/main results (e.g. categories/conclusions).
